



Up to 50% Funding on Solar Energy Systems with the LCBP Phase 2 Grant Scheme

SML has been appointed by the Government as a 'Framework Supplier' under the Low Carbon Buildings Programme (LCBP) Phase 2 scheme, meaning that SML's solar water heating and solar photovoltaic (PV) systems are subject to grants of up to 50% of the total purchase and installation cost.

LCBP Phase 2 Grant Eligibility

The LCBP Phase 2 scheme provides £50 million of capital grant funding for the installation of various microgeneration technologies – including solar water heating and PV – by organisations in the UK public and not-for-profit sectors, including local authorities, housing associations, schools, colleges, universities, hospitals, public service organisations and registered charities.

Leading 'Framework Supplier' for Solar

Under the rules of the programme, the supply and installation of these technologies can only be carried out by Framework Suppliers such as SML who have been appointed by the Government.
